**Advisory on Cyclone ‘AMPHAN’**

The cyclone “AMPHAN” completed its landfall by 7:00 PM (BST) as an Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm. Currently, the cyclone is crossing West Bengal coast Digha and Hatiya Islands, Bangladesh and to the Sundarbans. The system is likely to move North-Northeast. Under this system Bhutan has started experiencing overcast skies and light rainfall .

During the next 48 hours (21-22nd May), moderate rainfall is likely over northern, western and central parts; and moderate to heavy rainfall across southern and eastern parts of the country. Thunderstorms and gusty winds are likely over isolated parts of the country during the same period.

Periodic updates will be issued based on the severity of the system.
