OFFICE ORDER

In line with RCSC Order RCSC/LS-2/2019-2020/3482 dated 27 March 2020 to support the directives of the Government in the light of COVID 19 situation to prevent spreading through social distancing, the National Center for Hydrology and Meteorology (NCHM) called an emergency HRC meeting on 28 March 2020. The meeting endorsed the NCHM Continuity Service Delivery (CSD) Plan (version 1:00) and adopted the following.

- All those employees based on the nature of job responsibilities, where essential routine services can be delivered by working from home shall commence from 30 March 2020. However, Civil servants working from home/remote working must abide by the RCSC guideline which is enclosed (Annexure 1) and Protocol for Civil Servants staying at home (Annexure 2).
- 2. All those employees based on the nature of their job, where physical presence is required for delivery of critical services shall continue as per the normal routine or shift system with extra precautionary measures as advised by the Ministry of Health. These includes the operation and delivery of following hydro-met services:
 - a. Hydro-met observation, data collection and transmission from the hydro-met stations to HQ from all the site staff shall continue as per the routine functions to deliver weather, flood/GLOF early warning services for disaster preparedness and to maintain data continuity. This was decided as most of the hydro-met monitoring stations are located in isolated areas and most staff are staying in the government quarters near the stations.
 - b. 24/7 operation GLOF Early Warning Control Room at Wangdi, Trongsa (MHPA Dam colony) and Kurjey, Bumthang shall continue on shift system as per the existing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) considering the critical needs for real time monitoring and dissemination for flood/GLOF warning services for disasters preparedness. This was decided as most of the control room staff are staying in a dedicated government accommodation within the office premises and work does not involved large gathering.
 - c. 24/7 operation of National Weather and Flood Warning Center (NWFWC), HQ, Thimphu shall continue on shift system as per the existing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) as the NCFWC is the supervisory and command center to provide critical weather and flood warning services for disaster preparedness.
 - d. Aviation meteorological services at Paro International Airport and all the domestic airports shall continue functions as per the existing procedures based on operation of flights and helicopter services.
- Considering the technical nature of job and efficient services delivery will depend on the
 efficient operation and management of ITC facilities and databases. ICT staff shall
 continue providing technical backstopping and physical presence at the sites based on
 needs and during the emergencies.
