



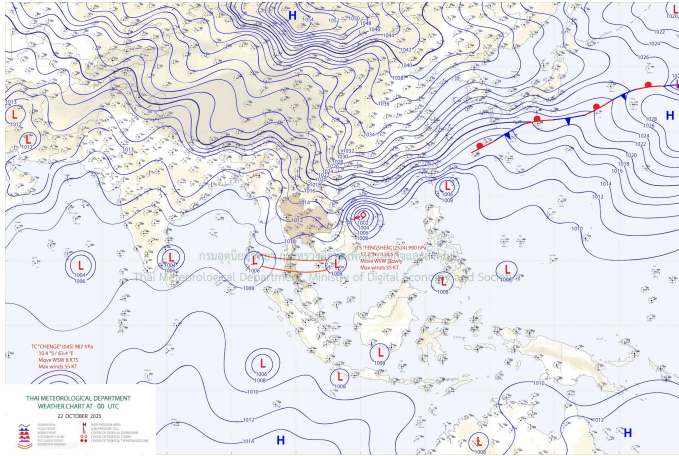
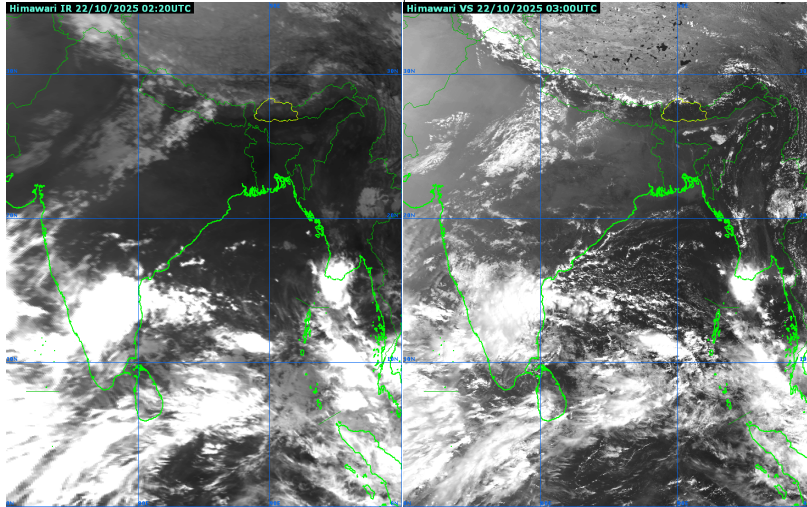

Weather Observation and Analysis	
1. Meteorological Observing Stations	Yesterday, stations across the country observed partly cloudy weather. No rainfall activity was recorded during the last 24 hours.
2. Surface Charts	The surface chart shows the low pressure system over southwest Bay of Bengal.  Figure: Weather chart updated at 00 UTC, 22nd October 2025 ThaiMet
3. Satellite Images	The satellite image shows Low clouds over the country.  Figure: Infrared Channel (IR) left and Visible channel (VS) right updated on 22nd October 2025
4. Indian Meteorological Department (IMD)	22-23 October 2025: Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall with isolated extremely heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Andhra Pradesh. 24- 28 October 2025: Heavy Rainfall very likely at isolated places over Andhra Pradesh. 21st - 24th October 2025:Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds very likely at isolated places over Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Meteorological Analysis; -The Well marked low pressure area over southwest Bay of Bengal off North Sri Lanka Coast moved northwestwards and lay over southwest Bay of Bengal off Tamil Nadu coast at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 22nd October 2025. While moving northwestwards, there is a possibility for the intensification into a depression over southwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal off north Tamil Nadu & south Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 12 hours. Thereafter, it is likely to move across north Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & south Andhra Pradesh coasts during subsequent 12 hours. -The Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level now runs roughly along Long. 66°E to the north of Lat. 25°N persists.

Weather Research and Forecasting Model

Precipitation: Partly to mostly cloudy weather is expected over the country with light rain/snow in a high altitude areas during the next 3 days.

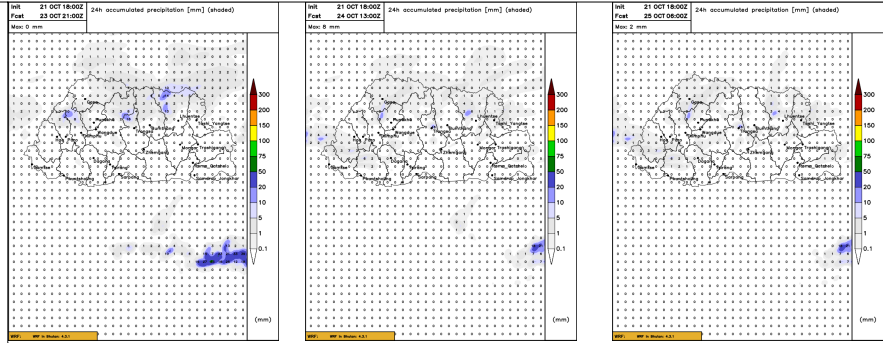


Figure: 24-hour total precipitation dated at 18:00 UTC, 21st October 2025

Wind : Mild wind gust over the country during the next 3 days.

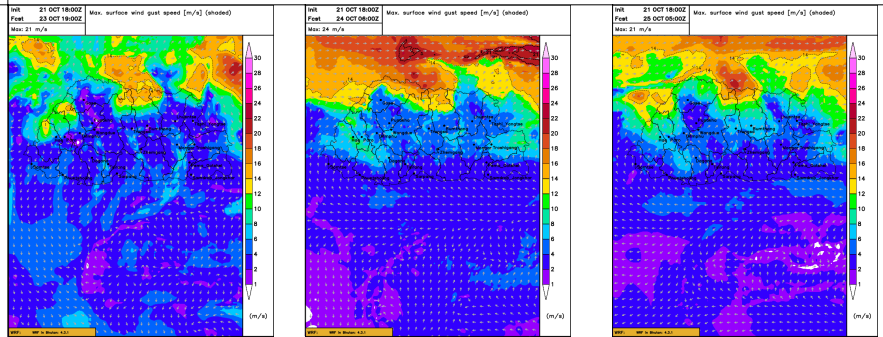


Figure: Wind Gust updated at 18:00 UTC, 21st October 2025

Thunderstorms: Thunderstorms are likely over isolated places of the country during the next 3 days.

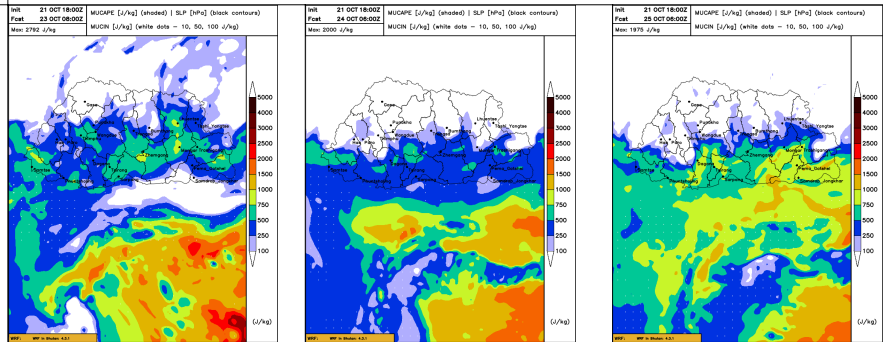


Figure: Mucape updated at 18:00 UTC, 21st October 2025
