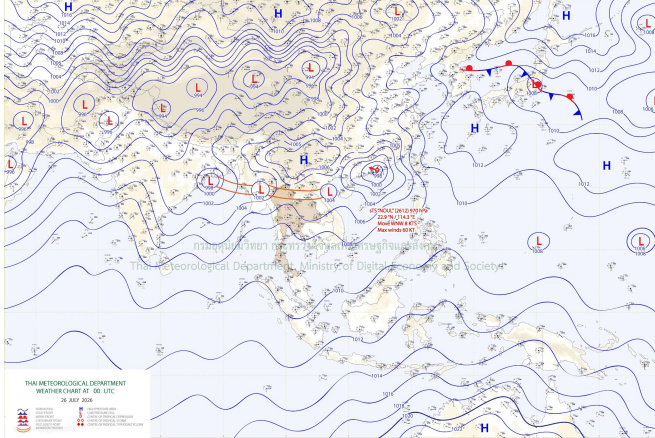
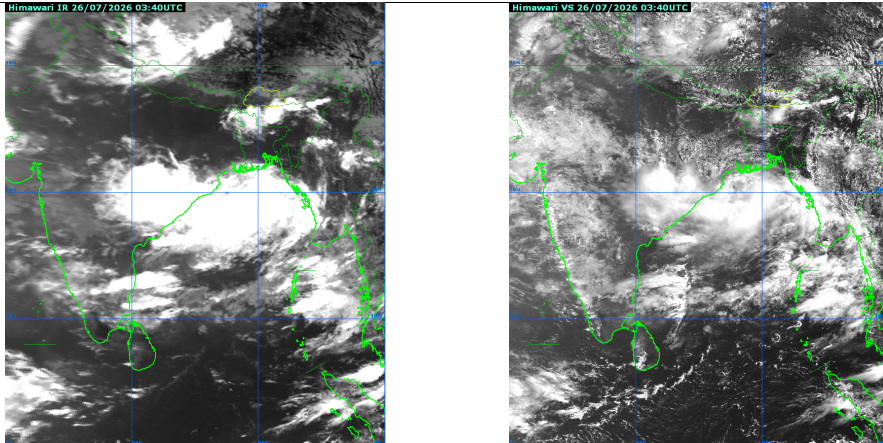

Weather Observations and Analysis	
1. Meteorological observing stations	Yesterday, meteorological stations across the country observed mostly cloudy weather conditions with light rainfall. The highest rainfall recorded was 2.2 mm in Gasa meteorological station during the last 24 hours. Note: A rainfall accumulation of 2.2mm is classified as light rainfall for Gasa Meteorological Station.
2. Surface Charts	The surface chart shows a low pressure area over the northwest Bay of Bengal.  Figure: Weather chart updated at 00 UTC, 26 July 2026 ThaiMet
3. Satellite Images	The satellite imagery shows scattered high and medium clouds over the country and Low Pressure Area over Northwest Bay of Bengal.  Figure: Infrared Channel (IR) left and Visible channel (VS) right updated on 26 July 2026
26 July- 01 August 2026: Heavy Rainfall very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Bihar, & Gangetic West Bengal. 26 July- 01 August 2026: Thunderstorm accompanied with Lightning very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura, Sub-himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim. 26 - 27 July & 31 July - 01 August :Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall very likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Assam & Meghalaya Meteorological Analysis; ❖ The Low Pressure Area over west Bengal coast & adjoining northwest Bay of Bengal lay as a Well-marked Pressure Area over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Odisha-West Bengal coasts at 0530 Hrs IST of today, 26th July 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extended upto 9.4 km above mean sea level. It is very likely to concentrate into a depression over the same region during next 12 hours. It is likely to move northwestwards and cross North Odisha-West Bengal Coasts around 27th July, 2026 forenoon. ❖ The Monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through centre of Low-pressure area over southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood, Ajmer, Gwalior, Satna, Keonjhar, centre of Well marked Low Pressure area over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Odisha-West Bengal coasts & thence southeastwards towards Northeast Bay of Bengal and extends upto 1.5 km above mean sea level. ❖ The Western Disturbance as a trough in middle & upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long 72°E to the north of Lat. 30°N persists

Precipitation: Mostly cloudy to cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall is expected across the country during the next three days.

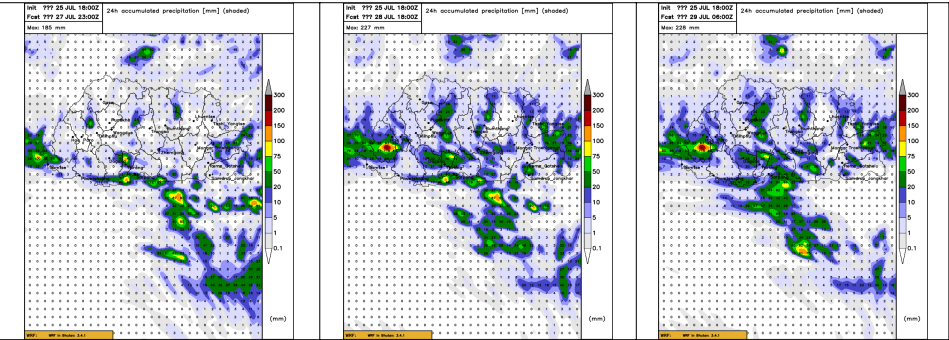


Figure: 24-hour total precipitation dated at 18 UTC, 25 July 2026

Wind: No severe wind gust over the country during the next three days.

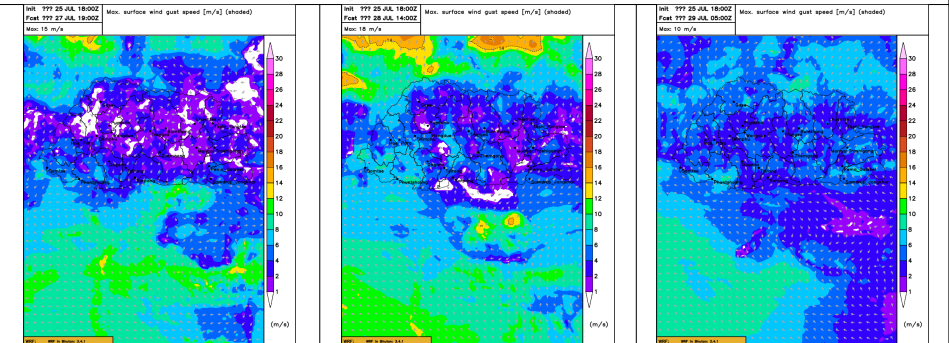


Figure: Wind Gust updated at 18 UTC, 25 July 2026

Thunderstorms: Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning likely over isolated places of the country during the next three days.

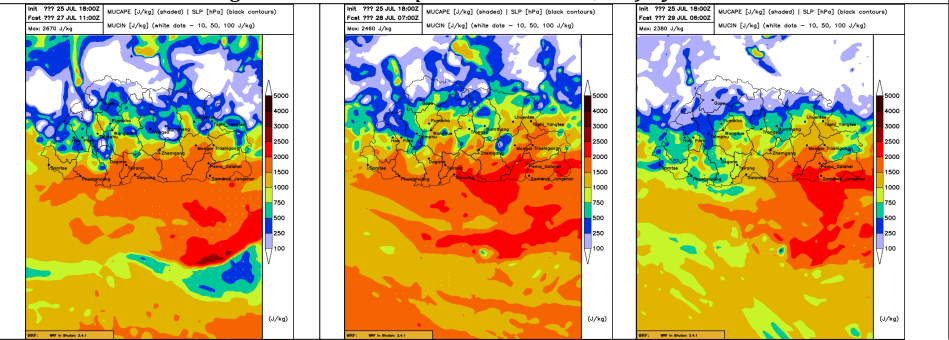


Figure: Mucape updated at 18 UTC, 25 July 2026
