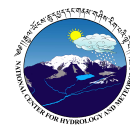

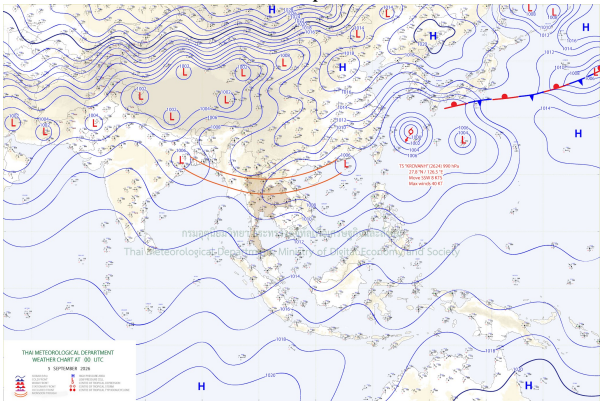
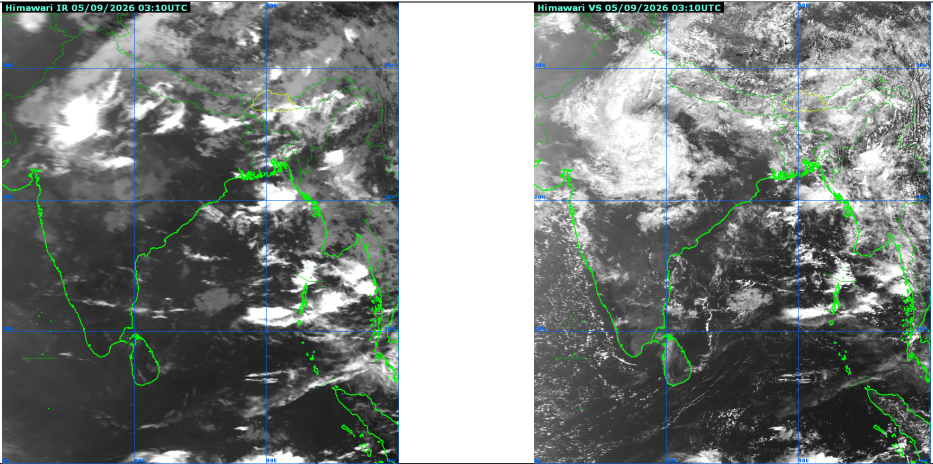

Weather Forecast Summary

6 - 8 September 2026: Mostly cloudy to cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall is expected across the country during the next three days.

Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning are also likely over the isolated parts of the country during this period.

Weather Observations and Analysis	
1. Meteorological observing stations	Yesterday, meteorological stations across the country observed mostly cloudy to cloudy weather conditions with light to moderate rainfall over the country. The highest rainfall recorded was 62.0mm at Sipsu meteorological station, under Samtse Dzongkhag during the past 24 hours. Note: A rainfall accumulation of 62.0mm is classified as moderate rainfall for Sipsu Meteorological Station.
2. Surface Charts	The surface chart shows the Well-Marked low pressure area over northwest Bay of Bengal.  <i>Figure: Weather chart updated at 00 UTC, 5 September 2026 ThaiMet</i>
3. Satellite Images	The satellite imagery shows scattered medium and high clouds over the country.  <i>Figure: Infrared Channel (IR) left and Visible channel (VS) right updated on 5 September 2026</i>
4. Indian Meteorological Department (IMD)	05 - 11 September 2026: Heavy Rainfall likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim. 05 - 09 September 2026: Thunderstorm accompanied with Lightning very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya. Meteorological Analysis; *The Well Marked low pressure area over central parts of northern Madhya Pradesh & adjoining south Uttar Pradesh lay over northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining southwest Uttar Pradesh at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 05th September 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. It is likely to be quasi-stationary over the same region during next 24 hours. *The trough from Northeast Rajasthan to Manipur across the cyclonic circulation associated with Well Marked low pressure area over northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining southwest Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, north Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, south Assam extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level persists. *The Western Disturbance as a trough in middle and upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level now runs roughly along Long. 68°E to the north of Lat. 32°N. *The upper air cyclonic circulation over northeast Assam & neighbourhood extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level persists. *The upper air cyclonic circulation over coastal Tamil Nadu & adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal at 7.6 km above mean sea level persists.

Weather Research and Forecasting Model

Precipitation : Mostly cloudy to cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall is expected across the country during the next three days.

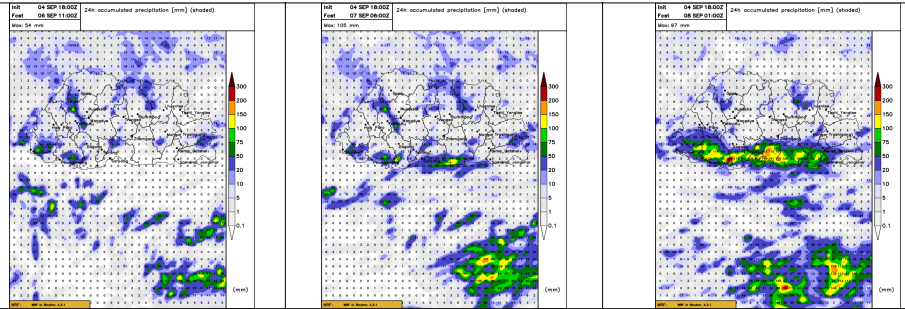


Figure: 24-hour total precipitation dated at 18 UTC, 04 September

Wind: No severe wind gusts during the next three days.

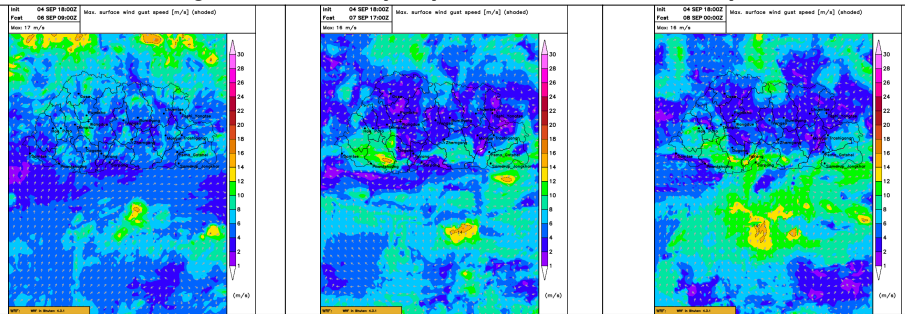


Figure: Wind Gust updated at 18 UTC, 04 September

Thunderstorms: Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning are likely over isolated places of the country during the next three days.

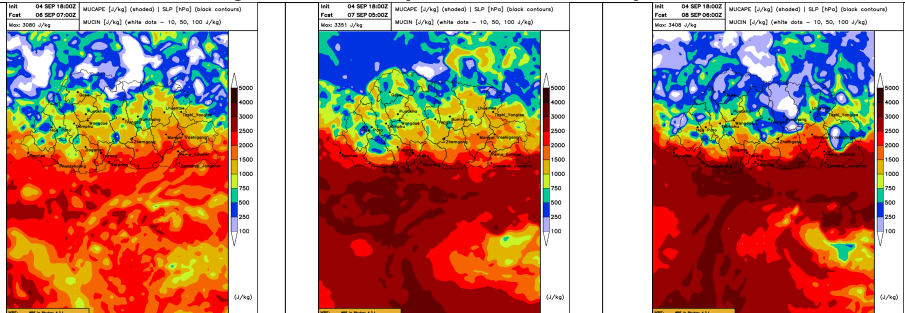


Figure: Mucape updated at 18 UTC, 04 September
