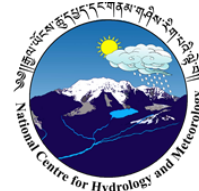

**Weather Remarks**

**Date and time of issue: 16th March 2023, 5:00 PM**

<b>Realised weather (last week)</b>	Mostly cloudy weather was observed over the country with light rainfall in the past 3 days. The highest rainfall was observed in Phuntsholing with 27.9 mm on the 15th of March 2023. Hailstorms were observed over central Bhutan while high-altitude areas received light snowfall on the 15th.
<b>Salient synoptic features</b>	A westerly trough is moving slowly over the Himalayas and is expected to bring some weather disturbance including moderate rain accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning.
<b>Weather Forecast</b>	
Mostly cloudy weather with light to moderate rain is expected over the country, with heavy rain likely over isolated places of the eastern parts of the country from 17-19 March 2023. Thunder/lightning and gusty wind are likely over isolated parts of the country during the same period. Light snowfall is also likely over high-altitude areas and passes.
