Weather Remarks

Date and time of issue: 16th March 2023, 5:00 PM

Realised weather (last week)	Mostly cloudy weather was observed over the country with light rainfall in the past 3 days. The highest rainfall was observed in Phuntsholing with 27.9 mm on the 15th of March 2023. Hailstorms were observed over central Bhutan while high-altitude areas received light snowfall on the 15th.
Salient synoptic features	A westerly trough is moving slowly over the Himalayas and is expected to bring some weather disturbance including moderate rain accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning.

Weather Forecast

Mostly cloudy weather with light to moderate rain is expected over the country, with heavy rain likely over isolated places of the eastern parts of the country from 17-19 March 2023.

Thunder/lightning and gusty wind are likely over isolated parts of the country during the same period.

Light snowfall is also likely over high-altitude areas and passes.
